The standard we will use is the set of guidelines in the HOA regulations. We will follow-up with letters reminding those neighbors of things they can do to improve the appearance of their property.

The things we are looking for are not new. It is the usual maintenance checklist: lawn mowed, property weeded, garbage cans stored out of sight, plants blocking public access, exterior in good repair, proper parking, cars registered, and other things of that nature.

Remember that the goal of all this is not to harass our neighbors, but to ensure that Hill Creek continues to be a friendly, safe, well-maintained neighborhood that also protects our investments in our homes.



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
